Saturday	21 st November	Rnd 1 – 28 Marked Field Round Rnd 2 – 14 Marked 3D Animal Round.
Sunday	22 nd November	Rnd 3 – 14 Marked 3D Animal Round Rnd 4 - 20 Marked International Round.

Programme:

Saturday	8.00am 8.15 to 8.45	Gates open at Whitford Gear inspection – all archers must have their gear inspected prior to the day starting. If your gear is not inspected you cannot go onto the courses. If you have a back up bow this be checked at the same time.
must	9.00am	Briefing – all archers must be present at the briefing. If you miss the briefing you cannot go onto the courses.
	9.15am 9.30am	Groups called Rnd 1 - Start shooting. Score cards checked, signed and handed into Registrar as soon as you leave the course.

	1.30 approx.	Start of Round 2 – Start shooting At the completion of Rnd 2 score cards checked, signed and handed into the Registrar as soon as you leave the course.

NOTE: All scorecards must be handed in at the end of each round – no scorecard – no score - if you leave the venue with the scorecards your score is not entered and cannot be entered the next day.

ROUNDS to be shot:

Rules for the rounds are available on www.nzfaa.org.nz – Archers Handbook. If you don't have access to this please contact Cheryl on 09 435 4174 after 5pm and she will get you a copy.

Round 1 IFAA 28 Field Round.

Notes:

- Normal 28 target round – shooting two up wherever possible.
- Bugs eyes – this target is to be shot in the following order – Top left – top right- bottom left – bottom right.
- Fan Shoots – where there are 2 faces up you must shoot 2 arrow into each target and one arrow at each peg so two right hand pegs – arrows shot into the right hand target – 2 left hand pegs – arrows shot into the left hand target.
- Walk ups – must be shot in order i.e. longest distance first down to the shortest distance – if you miss one you cannot go back and shoot it.
- Scoring is 5 for centre spot, 4 for the inner ring and three for the outer ring.

General:

All targets must be shot in sequence i.e. in numerical order if you start on target 1 it is straight forward – follow the course and check your target numbers ie 1,2,3,4, etc. If you start, on say, target 26 you would shoot 26, 27, 28, then 1,2,3 and so on.

If you miss out a target you cannot go back and shoot it – no score on that target.

As the Whitford course is well sign posted and numbered there should be no reason to miss out a target.

Round 2 & 3 14 3D Marked Animal Round.

This is an NZFAA round – but shoot to the Rules for the Marked Animal round in the Archers Handbook on the website – if you need a copy please let Cheryl know.

Note: All arrows must be “ringed” with one ring, two rings, three rings and arrows must be shot in order – but if you loose your first arrow then your number 2 arrow can become your first arrow.

Round 4 – 20 Marked International Round.

As this will be a new round for some archers the basic rules are:

- Shot on Hunter Face targets (all black with a white centre)
- 3 Arrows per target
- Longest distance 65 yards Seniors, 50 yards Juniors, 25 yards Cubs
- Scoring is 5 for the spot, four for the inner ring and three for the outer ring.
