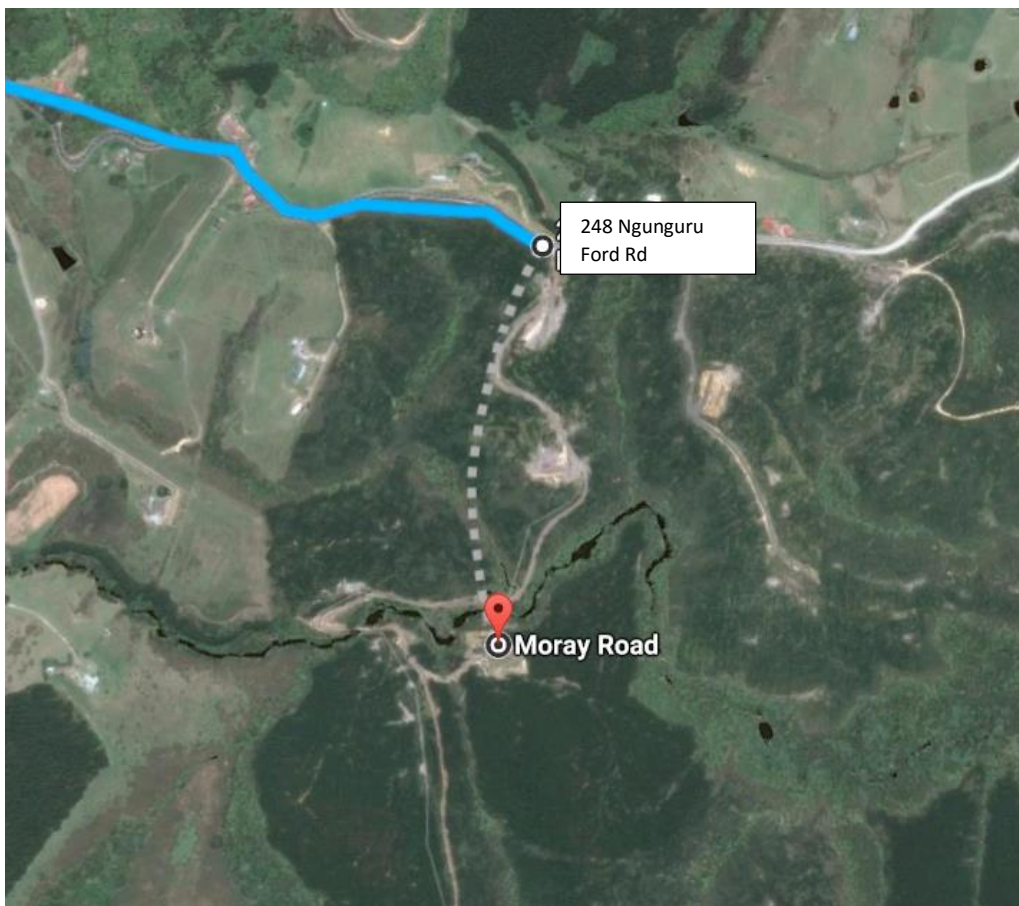
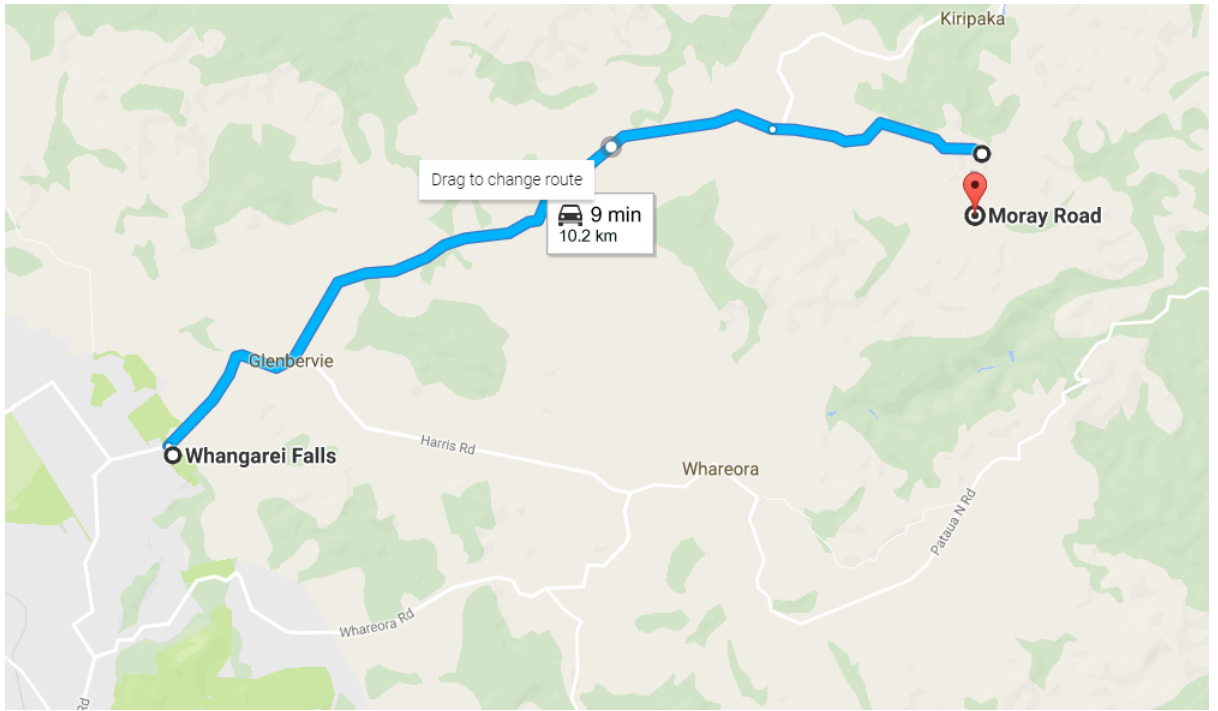

Toilets

We will have toilets by the range and around the course.

Cellphone Coverage is very limited at the range and we remind you that under IFAA rules cellphones are not permitted on the course unless needed for medical reasons. Please arrange this with the Registrar.

The Range

Mt Tiger Archery Club has a practice range with distances up to 60 yards available. On the practice day there will be hunter, field and animal targets available on the bales. Courses will be closed until the commencement of competition. Targets appropriate to the days' competition will be set out on the range daily. The range will be under the control of range officers, their instructions must be followed. Normal range safety rules apply.

Parking

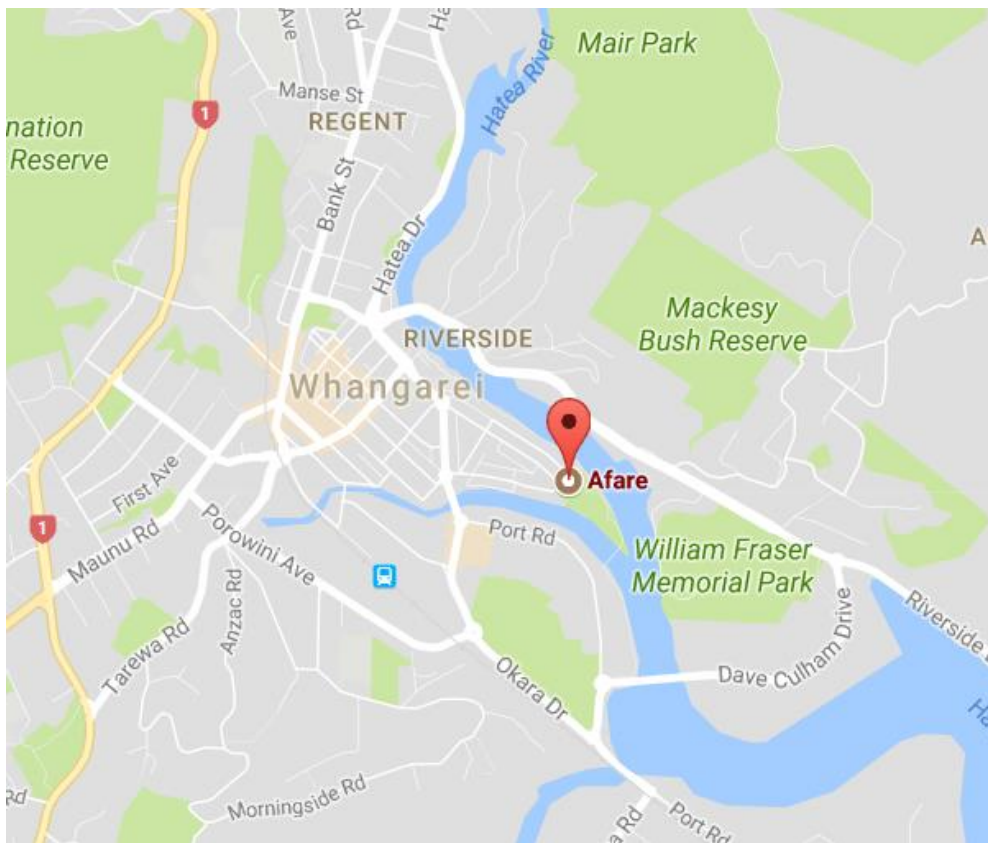

At the request of the forest management company, a viricidal footbath will be available at the club house to walk your boots through prior to entering the forested area. Please cooperate to prevent the spread of disease to this commercial forest.
