



Update on IFAA World Indoor Archery Championship - Wellington 2019 and NZFAA Sanctioned Indoor events.

Venue: The Wellington ASB Sports Centre

NZFAA has been working quietly behind the scenes in preparation for hosting the IFAA World Indoor Archery Championship – Wellington 2019.

This a prestigious event and opportunity to put NZ on the IFAA world archery map don't come along very often.

If you have every considered attending an IFAA world event this will be one of the closest and relatively cheaper for us Kiwis.

To participate in accordance with IFAA rules and compete at a World indoors event archers must belong to a member association of the IFAA (NZFAA for kiwis) and hold a valid IFAA score/classification card that shows 2 indoor event scores in past 12 months.

The purpose of this card is that it provides evidence that the archer has an understanding of the IFAA rules and shooting procedure of the rounds to be shot at this event.

For other World events these scores are used to grade archers but for this event **No grades are being applied**, all archers shoot against everyone in their division.

The NZFAA has been working with affiliated clubs and other Archery clubs that can host sanctioned indoor events to enable all NZFAA members to attend and attain the necessary scores.

Note for this World Event there is no minimum score or a selection score to be shot, you just have to do your best, competing against fellow archers in your division and clubs will pass on scores to National Register for them to be recorded against the Archers records and be ratified.

The National Registrar will be able to confirm score/classification card data for those NZFAA members registered for the event.

The current Sanctioned Indoor Events scheduled are:

Mt Tiger Archers – 28/29 July Whangarei Girls High School Gym flyer link
ArcheryNZ 2018 Indoor Nationals – 18/19 August Hosted by Mt Green Archery Club – Auckland Registration link
Gisborne Archery Club – 22/23 September Details coming soon
There are others being considered – watch out for details

These Sanctioned events are managed and run entirely by the host club with endorsement of NZFAA and technical assistance where necessary. Each event will have a prize giving for winning competitors in each division and score qualify for national records.

Event flyers and registration forms have been sent to clubs or you can get them direct from NZFAA or Archerynz website.

NZFAA promotes these events to all NZFAA and ArcheryNZ members particularly those wishing to attend the WIAC 2019.

The NZFAA welcomes affiliated clubs and other Archery clubs to host a sanctioned indoor event so we can get as many archers to experience the IFAA indoor rounds and meet the provisions to enter the WIAC2019. No event is too big/small to be considered
