The round to be shot is the IFAA Standard Indoor Round.  
The distance for Adults/Juniors is 20 yards, and Cubs 10 yards.

- The shooting line capacity per round is 8 archers and will be run as a double detail, with alternating pairs of archers.
- There will be a limit of 2 cub per round – 10yds
- Archers to advise event date, name, NZFAA number, division, target type, number of rounds and River Glade archers will do their best to accommodate request and confirm booking and payment instructions
- Registration and equipment check 30 mins before start times
- Archers must provide own food and refreshments
