## IFAA Standard Indoor Rounds

Mana archery will host a NZFAA Sanctioned Indoor Event at its indoor range, BlackHawk Wellington Exhibition Centre, 11 Prosser Street, Eldson, Porirua 5022. Select here for [map](#). Registration form [here](#)

This indoor event will allow archers to produce scores essential for the participation at the IFAA 2019 World indoors to be held in wellington 8-12 April 2019 – [www.wiacnz2019.org](http://www.wiacnz2019.org)

The rounds to be shot is the IFAA standard indoor round. The event consists of TWO standard indoor rounds, each 60 arrows shot in 12 ends of 5 arrows each. A total of 120 arrows for the day.

- Registration must be online before the event. This is to allow target allocation and preparation.
- Equipment inspection 9:15 am
- The 1<sup>st</sup> round will start at 10:00 am
- Shooting line is limited to 32 archers. The round will be shot in double detail if entries are 17 or more.
- Maximum bow poundage is 60 lb
- Target butt lube is recommended on all arrows and essential on carbon arrows.
- Bow divisions as per IFAA rules.
- Age division determined by age at event. Cubs limited to 4 entries.

The event format:

1. Distance for Adults, juniors is 20 yards. Cubs 10 yards (entry for cubs is limited to 4 entries)
2. Target face will be PAA targets. On the online entry archers must select either single face or 5 spot.
3. Pre-registration using the online entry is essential.
4. Fees: Veterans, Senior, Young adult and Juniors \$35, Cubs \$20
5. All payments to be online unless by prior arrangement with host club. Bank account Internet Banking to Westpac Account: 06-0565-0558773-00
6. Each end is timed at 4 minutes.
7. Each 60 arrow round consists of:
  - a. 2 practice ends before start of round
  - b. 1<sup>st</sup> Round half, 6 ends of 5 arrows,
  - c. A short break to allow checking of target faces and archers to swap from top pair to bottom pair and vice versa
  - d. Final half of 1<sup>st</sup> round of 6 ends of 5 arrows (no practice rounds prior)
  - e. Scores checked, signed and handed in to Admin.
8. A lunch break of 30-45 mins is planned between round 1 and round 2, 30 mins between round 2 and 3.
9. After round 2 all scores reviewed and placings announced.
10. Winners receive certificate placings for combined score of the two rounds in each division.
